Please do not phone reception to check on your appointment or to ask when your vaccination will be, we will contact you.

Woburn surgery update - From Monday 4th January Woburn Surgery will be open to patients and carers for medication collection only. We will continue to provide care and support for all our patients. If you phone Woburn Surgery the call will still be answered as we have a single phone system. In order to protect patients and staff from the more infectious new variant of Covid 19 we will continue to manage conditions by phone, online or video consultations where it is clinically safe to do so.

Face to face patient services and consultations will be provided at Asplands Medical Centre. Please be assured that we are following strict hygiene measures if we need to bring patients into the surgery to be seen.
