In the meantime can we remind people of the current guidance from the NHS and Public Health England:

Wash your hands regularly

Stay at home for 7 days if you have either:

- High temperature (37.8 degrees centigrade or above)
- New continuous cough

DO NOT go to a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital

You do not need to contact 111 to arrange testing for coronavirus or to inform them that you are staying at home.

Please do use the 111 **online** Coronavirus service if:

- You feel that you cannot cope with your symptoms at home
- Your condition gets worse
- Your symptoms do not get better after 7days.

Only call 111 if you don't have access to 111 online or you cannot get the help you need from 111 online.

For other medical problems Asplands is open as usual but please be advised will be offered a phone call first.

While for the majority of people Coronavirus is a mild self-limiting illness it is important we work together to protect members of our community who may be more susceptible to severe infection.
